Background

The National Disaster Risk Management Fund (NDRMF) is committed to strengthening Pakistan's resilience and to reduce the socio economic and fiscal vulnerability of populations against natural and human-induced hazards through evidence-based interventions. The M&E Department plays a central role in ensuring accountability, learning, and performance improvement across the Fund's operations by embedding robust monitoring systems and evaluation frameworks. The RA-M&E will support the department in enhancing performance tracking, documentation, data analysis, and learning across funded initiatives.

Objectives of the Role

The RA-M&E will support the design, implementation, and documentation of the M&E framework and its application across projects. The role entails contributing to data collection, synthesis, reporting, and evaluation processes. The RA will assist the M&E team in ensuring that evidence-based insights inform project management and strategic decision-making, while maintaining compliance with internal quality standards and donor requirements.

Key Responsibilities

1. Data Management & Monitoring Support

- Support in the collection, cleaning, and consolidation of M&E data from implementing partners.
- Assist in updating and maintaining project performance tracking tools and dashboards.
- Participate in the development of data collection instruments and validation protocols.

2. Documentation & Reporting

- Draft monthly, quarterly, and annual M&E reports, briefs, and knowledge products.

- Ensure timely compilation of field monitoring reports and evaluation summaries.
- Contribute to donor reporting through generation of evidence-based narratives and data inputs.

 - Provide logistical and analytical support to field visits, including checklist development and data gathering.
 - Support the implementation of data verification and spot-check protocols.
 - Document key findings from monitoring missions and generate actionable recommendations.

 - Contribute to learning reviews, evaluation studies, and outcome tracking efforts.
 - Conduct desk reviews, data triangulation, and basic statistical analysis as required.
 - Assist in designing results frameworks and outcome monitoring matrices.

 - Support efforts in digitizing M&E workflows and adopting new tools for real-time tracking.
 - Assist with testing, updating, and managing online data portals and GIS-enabled systems.
 - Coordinate with the MIS/IT unit for troubleshooting data management issues.
- 6. Stakeholder Engagement & Capacity Support**
 - Support in organizing M&E-related workshops, learning sessions, and capacity-building initiatives.
 - Provide technical backstopping to implementing partners on M&E guidelines and tools.
 - Maintain effective communication with internal departments for streamlined reporting processes.
- 7. Other Responsibilities**
 - Perform any other tasks assigned by the Manager – M&E in alignment with departmental objectives.
 - Ensure confidentiality, data integrity, and compliance with NDRMF's M&E protocols.
