4	Lot No.2: Proposing local RAMS	-do-	Local RAMs shall not be quoted unless duly aligned with OEM's requirement of void warranty of already installed components.
5	Lot No.1: Bidder asked that as per their understanding, there are two racks, each equipped with a 10KVA UPS and currently using 16 batteries of 9Ah capacity. We understand that the scope involves replacing these with 16 batteries of 100Ah capacity per UPS. Kindly confirm if this is correct.	-do-	No replacement of batteries is required. Instead NDRMF needs to enhance the battery backup as per specifications and quantities mentioned in the Section V: Specification and Schedule of Requirements.
6	Lot No. 1: Is there sufficient space to accommodate two battery racks with 32 batteries of 12V-100Ah capacity (i.e., 16 x 100Ah batteries per rack/UPS)?	-do-	Additional batteries as per Section V: Specification and Schedule of Requirements are required along with a battery container/ battery bank. There is no space in existing racks for additional battery backup.
7	Lot No.1: Can you please confirm if the UPS chargers are compatible with 100Ah batteries? If not readily available, we request you to kindly confirm this with the UPS vendor (Atom).	-do-	It is the bidder's responsibility to ensure that the provided batteries are compatible with the existing UPS.
8	Lot No.1: Whether representatives from the UPS vendor be present on-site during the battery replacement to ensure proper UPS configuration and to avoid any compatibility or operational issues.	-do-	Firstly, it is reiterated that it's not replacement of batteries rather additional batteries are required as per Section V: Specification and Schedule of Requirements. NDRMF can align OEM (Atom) representatives for this activity if required.
